- 1. **PUBLIC FORUM** (Order of business changed- item 3 brought forward to item 1)
 - Cars parked on Fryer Road bend create a pinch point the road used to have road markings.
 - MOP request received via email for anti HS2 banner to be removed from the gyratory.
 - Half of the WS trailers have gone.
 - Concern about dogs barking on Moss Lane- Clerk to pass onto neighbouring parish.

2. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

The PC **RESOLVED** to accept apologies and reasons for absence from Cllr M Venables and Cllr I Parkinson, Cllr P Walker was absent.

PCSO Hambleton sent his apologies.

3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Cllr K Hodgkinson and Cllr T Hodges declared a personal interest in Lostock Gralam Community Centre as members of the Community Centre Association Committee.

4. MINUTES

The Parish Council **RESOLVED** to accept the Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting held on Monday 2nd December 2024, having been copied to members was taken as read and confirmed as being a correct record.

5. PROGRESS REPORT

- 1) Foliage which was left on Stubbs Lane grass verge has been removed.
- 2) The Clerk has reported two sunken areas in the middle of Station Road, CWAC has closed the case advising that no safety concerns were identified.
- 3) The Clerk has reported the leaves on Stubbs Lane, Hall Lane footpath and Manchester Road footpath refs SS669441622, SS669436482 and SS669434405.
- 4) The Clerk is working on a grant policy in collaboration with Cllr Ross, Cllr Litton and Cllr Smith.
- 5) The Clerk has submitted a request to move the Townshend Rd bin. Awaiting response. Ref SS671205571.
- 6) CWAC Highways advised that two new boundary signs, and the repositioning of two existing signs will cost an estimated £1500 which is in excess of the sum the parish council had earmarked for the project. Cllr M Stocks agreed to match fund and contribute £750.00 to the project. The parish council

RESOLVED to proceed with the purchase of the new signs and thanked Cllr Stocks for his Members Budget Grant towards the project.

6. POLICE

7. MARK STOCKS

- -WS have lodged an appeal with the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) against the CWAC decision to refuse planning permission. CWAC are still awaiting to hear from PINS as to how the appeal will be considered. CWAC will wait for a decision before taking action.
- -Council Tax will go up by around 5%.
- -The garden bin charge has increased to £52.50.
- -Most public concern Cllr Stocks receives is about highways, pot holes, gullies, and road sweeping. CWAC are looking to purchase an additional sweeper for the borough.
- -Councils will receive government funding specifically for potholes, the funding will be spread across a number of years.
- -Cllr P Cobley asked if the Barrat and Bellway estate has been adopted.

8. PRECEPT

The PC considered the £33,210 precept budget requirement for 2025/26. The PC considered a possible cost saving to reduce the precept request, the council agreed to not collect the grass cuttings from the Stubbs Lane play area, reducing the precept request for the year to £32,712.

The PC, **RESOLVED** to request a precept of £32,712 which is a 15.1% increase on last year. The annual band D charge will therefore increase from £36.47 to £41.99.
